Summary & background:

This project was initiated by several guiding questions including:

- What types of youth programming exists in Kensington, with an emphasis on the 19134 zip code?
- Who is providing the programming?
- Why is there a perception (throughout Philadelphia) that there aren't any, or aren't enough, opportunities or programs for children, and especially teens?

Our research consisted of internet and database searches, knowledge from prior partnerships, and from organization referrals. We looked through websites and social media pages to come up with as much initial information as possible, and followed up by phone and email. As we compiled information, we formatted our data in a way that allowed us to answer any other emerging questions.

This database is location specific. It serves as both a search and networking tool for youth organizations, as well as families residing in Kensington. Unlike Philadelphia's OST Finder, which only includes city funded programs throughout Philadelphia, this database is comprehensive in that it supports all programs regardless of source of funding.

For this version of the document, we decided to only include organizations in the 19134 zip code. We are planning to include organizations in the 19122 and 19125 zip codes for the next version of this tool.



Who initiated this project?

Fab Youth Philly initiated this project. We have been providing workforce development opportunities in Kensington since 2017 and are looking to expand our offerings. It is always our approach to try not to duplicate services or offerings, and rather create new opportunities or fill gaps, so we wanted to know what gaps in youth programming existed.

Fab Youth Philly (FYP) has a unique, holistic model for youth development. First, we provide innovative, award-winning summer and afterschool programs for teens with a focus on workforce development.

Second, we **connect with youth development professionals** through our Center for Youth Development Professionals (CYDP), which offers competency-based professional development and networking opportunities.

Third, we are hired by other youth-serving organizations to provide a range of consulting services, ranging from curriculum development to retreats and small conferences.

This three-pronged approach to youth development is aimed at creating relevant, engaging, and empowering learning opportunities at the individual, professional, and community level.



Who worked on this project?



THE PROJECT WAS COMPILED OVER THE COURSE OF TWO MONTHS. GRAPHS AND REPORTS WERE GENERATED DURING MONTH FOUR BASED ON THE MOST CURRENT INFORMATION WE HAD.

As we organized data into graphs and reflected on our process, we became aware of several noteworthy pieces of information that were either surprising or that contradicted what we initially thought:

- While there are some organizations that have formal mentoring programs, many others include mentoring in their description as an additional aspect of their programming.
- The majority of the programs (62.1%)
 included in this database are free/no cost
 while another 6.9% are sliding scale or by
 donation.
- There are more arts programs than anticipated (12.8%).
- At least one fifth of organizations included are geared towards high school students.





Programs by Audience Ages


